

DISTRICT COMMISSION ON EVANGELISM

The AZ-CA District Commission on Evangelism exists to assist congregations to seize every opportunity the Lord provides to evangelize lost souls, making use of media communications, structured programs and every member witness.

I. School of Outreach (SoO)

The School of Outreach remains our #1 hands-on effort to help congregations reach out with the Gospel. The curriculum is divided into two one-day seminars. The presenters work with the congregations during their planning sessions and then follow up with the leaders of the congregations to offer continued support.

Session One: (September-October)

1. Organizing / Planning for Outreach
2. Locating Prospects
3. Prospect Nurture and Witness

Session Two: (January-February)

1. Friendship Evangelism
2. Church Identity
3. Worship Welcome
4. Assimilation

Over the past 3 years, Pastor Mike Hintz has been training the pastors of each districts' Evangelism Commission to lead SoO. This continues to be a blessing for our synod as more congregations/members are able to attend.

In our district this is also true: 3 ½ Schools of Outreach are underway this fall/winter. A follow-up session was held with Christ – Lodi over Labor Day weekend with 15 people. Over 25 people attended Part I in Redding, CA on Sept 21. (Mt. Calvary – Redding; Faith – Anderson; Gloria Dei – Belmont) Part II is scheduled for Feb 8. On Feb 9, Part II will be presented in Reno / Sparks. Part I was Jan 8, 2011.

Six + congregations are signed up for SoO in Las Vegas on November 2. (From Las Vegas: Water of Life, Summerlin, Shepherd of the Hills, Mt. Olive; Cross of Christ – Kingman, AZ; Shepherd – Albuquerque, NM) The African congregation which meets at Water of Life is attending. Pastor Peter Kruschel will assist them.

Our District Commission is meeting this week to talk about future plans. If you would like to host a session please speak to one of the members.

II. Resources Available

One of our goals of expanding our District Evangelism Team is to include members in the various geographical areas so that at your circuit meetings or other gatherings, they might regularly promote the resources available.

- **Devotional booklets for Lent and Easter** (NPH 388018 & 388019). These devotional booklets, **Jesus' Death and Resurrection** and **Philippians**, can be distributed to members and friends. 10 booklets for \$15.
- **Confidently Sharing Jesus with Friends** is a 4-week DVD Bible Study that provides advice and encouragement to help you talk about Jesus with people you know. A group of Christians discuss the opportunities, challenges, and aspects of reaching out to their friends with the good news of Jesus Christ. \$3.95 OL-388016 1) *Reach people who need Jesus;* 2) *Start a spiritual conversation;* 3) *Share our Savior;* 4) *Keep on sharing Jesus*
- **Outreach Newsletters** are a collection of twelve short articles with a common Biblical theme that emphasize the Gospel. The cost is \$15 plus s/h. It is item number OL-388027.
- Web-based resources include: **WhatAboutJesus.com & Daily Devotions**. Promote these for your members in your newsletters and bulletins.
- CMSG (Congregational & Ministry Support Group) has finalized materials for **C13**. If you registered you are getting the links, otherwise resources are available on WELS Connect. The resources include helps for planning outreach and worship for Advent and Christmas. The deadline has passed for ordering postcards.

- **Evangelism Toolbox** is a set of 3 DVDs with practical instruction to help your congregation understand and undertake useful tools for an evangelism program. In 9 segments, experienced church leaders explain key outreach methods and demonstrate them with real-life examples. The cost is \$24 from NPH OL-388013.

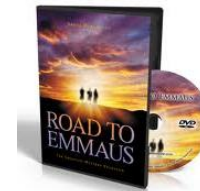
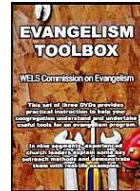
