Subject: Board for World Missions Organization

- WHEREAS 1) the Board for World Missions was reorganized to five elected members who appoint members to eight administrative committees; and
- WHEREAS 2) the Board for World Missions has asked each committee to unify the planning processes so that the impact of their planning takes into account how it affects other committees and mission fields; and
- WHEREAS 3) the committees seem to be carrying this directive out; and
- WHEREAS 4) this plan also encourages better communication between committees and mission fields; therefore, be it

- Resolved, b) that we encourage the Board and committees to continue with God-pleasing coordination of their work; and be it further
- Resolved, c) that we also encourage the Board and committees to find ways of coordinating with the various para-synodical groups, congregations and individuals in matters where such coordination could be mutually beneficial; and be it finally
- Resolved, d) that we encourage the Board and committees to find ways of communicating with the specific areas of mission and ministry as efficiently as possible.
