



WHEREAS 1) The 2008 AZ-CA District Convention passed the following resolution:

Resolution #3

Subject: Help for Called Workers and their Families

Reference: District President’s Report page 2 (District Reports page 19)

WHEREAS 1) a resignation from the ministry often brings hardship to the called worker and his or her family,

WHEREAS 2) Christians concern and support for those who have resigned and their families has been an issue, and

WHEREAS 3) Christian love compels us to do what we can for those former called workers and their families, therefore be it

Resolved, a) that the District Presidium look into developing a procedure for helping those who have resigned from the ministry, and be it further

Resolved, b) that the District Presidium make full use of the career transition tools offered by Wisconsin Lutheran Child and Family Service and Wisconsin Lutheran College, and be it further

Resolved, c) that the District Presidium consider implementing a program similar to the Help Team of the Michigan District.

THE RESOLUTION PASSED

and

WHEREAS 2) the AZ-CA District Presidium wishes to implement this resolution; and

WHEREAS 3) implementation of this resolution requires an organizational structure; therefore be it

Resolved, a) that the 2014 AZ-CA District Convention authorize the establishment of a committee structure for a District Help Team; and be it further

Resolved, b) that this committee consist of a chairman, elected at this convention, and two members from each conference of the District appointed by the Presidium until that Conference meets; and be it further

Resolved, c) that the conferences elect these Help Team members at their next regularly scheduled meeting; and be it finally

Resolved, d) that the District Presidium continue to develop guidelines for the Committee and made available to the Circuit Pastors.
